

## **COACHES CHARTER – Mini & Juniors**

As a member of Farnborough RFC M&J coaching team you will be expected to:

- Undertake appropriate vetting (enhanced DBS) according to RFU Guidelines.
- Be willing to learn and adapt your coaching style according to the needs of the age group (to include attending training where identified, annual CPD sessions to maintain RFU Coaching License and attending Annual Coaching Conference if available)
- Wherever possible, be willing to assist with coaching as directed by the Head Coach, in groups and fixtures/venues which sometimes may and occasionally MAY NOT include your own child.
- Be willingly to travel to AWAY venues as required.
- Be available to assist with coaching on a regular basis and to inform the Head Coach when not available.
- Be willing to support refereeing requirements within the coaching team, and when required, attend RFU Refereeing briefings to maintain an understanding of laws and age group variations.
- Deliver appropriate training to players in a manner as directed by the Head Coach always with enjoyment and safety foremost.
- Conduct yourself in an appropriate manner as an exemplary role model to the players in your age group and others – this includes no smoking or drinking alcohol, no dissent towards fellow teams, coaches or officials nor using bad language whilst responsible for the players.
- Uphold and support the policies and procedures of Farnborough RFC and of the RFU
- Commit to assisting the club for at least a season if the club has paid for you to attend First Aid, Foundation (Rugby Ready) Course or referees course to a certificated level.

- Commit to assisting the club for at least 2 seasons, if the club has paid for you to attend level 1 Coaching Course or above.
- Engage in fundraising activities and help in securing sponsorship for the age group.
- Uphold the agreements above and all Farnborough RFC club policy: if you cannot uphold this agreement for any reason, you may be asked
